Dirt, dust, sweat, skin oil, spilled beverages, smoke and other gunk can prematurely age the finish and hardware. Basic cleaning know-how can go a long way toward keeping your gear looking beautiful and spark-ly!



Tips for Cleaning and Care of your new West Coast Pedal Board:

Wipe the painted surface with a lint-free cloth. Lint free is the Key here, no scratchy old sock!

Wipe metal parts clean with a soft, dry polishing cloth. You don't need to spray anything on them; simply wiping them off will usually suffice.

Clean Finished wood surfaces with cleaning agents that are typically made for guitars. Care products are available at most music stores and its more then likely that you already have what you need! If your unsure, test on a hidden portion of the underside surface.

Do not use anything other than what we just told you about to clean Finished wood surfaces. Do not use glass cleaner (or anything with ammonia in it) or products containing abrasives or silicon (as some paste cleaners do). **Play it safe by sticking to cleaners and polishes made specifically for guitars.**
